7. What are some of the ways “God is making his appeal through you”?
8. Christ tells us it is our job to represent Him to a hurting, hopeless, lost and dying world. Look at the four words Chris says will help us in our mission engagement.
 - A. IDENTIFY – make a list of people you know without Christ
 - B. INTERCEDE – Pray for them consistently
 - C. INVEST – Purposefully build your relationship with those people
 - D. INVITE – Share your story and invite them to follow Jesus
